In addition, I certify that my (our) son/daughter, in case of an emergency situation when the parents/guardians are not readily available, do authorize any member of the faculty or staff to exercise supervision, discipline, and control over said student, and further authorizes him/her to consent to any x-ray examination, anesthetic, medical or surgical diagnosis or treatment and hospital care upon the advice of a physician and surgeon licensed under the provisions of the Medical Practice Act.

Tryout/Team Selection Information

I understand that I am trying out for a place on a team. All qualified student-athletes (academically, CIF and school), may try out for membership on sports teams. Prior to tryouts, no one is guaranteed a place on a team including all returning athletes. The coaching staff will be fair and work in good faith during the tryout process and throughout the season. Unfortunately, not everyone who tries out can be accepted onto a team. The decision of the coaching staff, in conjunction with the athletic director is final.

No player will be put on a roster without this form being completed and in the coach's possession. Prior to the start of the season, all parents are expected to attend a mandatory meeting for each program. If a parent/guardian does not attend the meeting, the student-athlete cannot participate in practice or competition until contact is made and the athlete is cleared with the coach.

Christian Brothers High School, as a member of the Sac-Joaquin Section (SJS) of the California Interscholastic Federation (CIF), is committed to the exhibition of sportsmanlike and ethical behaviors in and around all athletic events. All contests must be safe, controlled, fair, courteous and orderly for all athletes and fans. As a member of the SJS and CIF, Christian Brothers shall require that the following Code of Ethics and CIF Steroids forms are signed by student-athletes and parents/guardians each year prior to participation.

Code of Ethics:

1. To emphasize the proper ideals of sportsmanship, ethical conduct and fair play.
2. To eliminate all possibilities which tend to destroy the best values of the game.
3. To stress the values derived from playing the game fairly.
4. To show cordial courtesy to visiting teams and officials.
5. To establish a happy relationship between visitors and hosts.
6. To respect the integrity and judgment of sports officials.
7. To achieve a thorough understanding and acceptance of rules of the game and the standards of eligibility.
8. To encourage leadership, use of initiative and good judgment by all players on the team.
9. To recognize that the purpose of athletics is to promote the physical, mental, moral, social and emotional well being of the individual players.
10. To remember that an athletic contest is a game – not a matter of life and death for the player, coach, school, officials, fan, community, state or nation.

CIF Bylaw 524: Steroid Agreement

As a condition of membership in the CIF, all schools shall adopt policies prohibiting the use and abuse of androgenic/anabolic steroids. All member schools shall have participating students and their parents, legal guardian/caregiver agree that the athlete will not use steroids without the written prescription of a fully licensed physician (as recognized by the AMA) to treat a medical condition (Bylaw 524).

By signing below, both the participating student-athlete and the parents, legal guardian/caregiver hereby agree that the student shall not use androgenic/anabolic steroids without the written prescription of a fully licensed physician (as recognized by the AMA) to treat a medical condition. We also recognize that that under CIF Bylaw 200.D., there could be penalties for false or fraudulent information. We also understand that the Christian Brothers High School policy regarding the use of illegal drugs will be enforced for any violations of these rules.
