WHY 1 TO 1 IPADS?

- We live in an age where students MUST know how to positively and productively use technology for their own personal and academic enrichment and to be successful in the workplace.
- Differentiation and individualization of student assignments
- Foster creativity and innovation

What Should Kids be doing with them?

- Access Schoology and PowerSchool
- **Manage** information including course notes, assignments in a paperless environment.
- Conduct research.
- Create and convey content that illustrates understanding of course material.
- **Communicate** appropriately with classmates, teachers, counselors and administrators.

Responsible use of technology

Responsible use of technology (Responsible Use Policy) Parent Student Handbook p. 14-17

- Use of a hotspot, proxy server or VPN (Virtual Private Network) to bypass the network restrictions is strictly prohibited
- CB does not allow the distribution of unauthorized test or exam information via cell phone, iPad, smart watch, etc
- Cameras and microphones may be used in the classroom only with permission by the teacher
- CB reserves the right to inspect the contents of any electronic device brought on campus
- Use of school's name or logos or use that negatively impact the school's reputation is strictly prohibited
- Cyber bullying/harassment: distributing content that attempts to be harmful or cruel to another student or individual through offensive electronic communication.
- Serious incidents, including "sexting" or threats, or intentionally embarrassing students, teachers or staff, will be turned over to law enforcement authorities.

iPad Temporary Replacement Program

- If student's device is lost, stolen or broken student can have an iPad loaned for two weeks
- iPad loaner request form is available at the front office
- iPad must be returned in same condition

SAFETY TIPS FOR STUDENTS

- Make iPad identifiable from a distance
- Password protect the device—keep it private
 - Know your student's pw
- Be sure "find my iPad" is turned on
- Back up data—have a system for doing so (iCloud or other)
- Get a good case—protect the corners

- Make sure students have strong passwords
- Teach them to protect their online identity

GUIDED ACCESS

- General > Accessibility > Guide Access
- Can be configured to work with any application on the device
- Locks the student in one app
- Prevents students from exiting the app



RESTRICTIONS

- Setup restrictions on the iPad.
- You can create a separate restrictions passcode that will shut of iMessage for a certain period of time.
- You can also delete apps
- Set content for websites and music

When you use a parent access code to create an account, you will be automatically associated to the student.



- 1. Click on the downfacing arrow on the top right of your schoology account.
- Below your name, you'll see the name of the child associated with your account. If you have linked accounts in schoology, to view the activity of a particular child, click the child's name from the dropdown menu.
- 3. Clicking on the student name will display their summary page (see below).
- 4. When you have multiple children in the same school, clicking on the icon to the right of the student name will take you to their profile.



View course as the student- clicking on the course name allows you to view the course as your child views the course.

The enrollments area displays a list of all of the child's courses and groups. Depending on the settings in place at your school



On the right column of the summary page, the recent grades/attendance area lists graded assignments, tests/quizzes, and discussions for the student. To view the graded items click on the item you'd like to view.
