CANCELLATION OF CLASSES

Christian Brothers reserves the right to cancel any course with insufficient enrollment.

SUMMER SESSION FEES

Tuition Policy: Tuition must be paid in full at time of registration.

DROPPING COURSES

Course changes are allowed only on the first day of classes. No refund is issued for any course dropped after the second day of classes.

TEXTBOOKS

Students must purchase necessary textbooks prior to summer school from the school's online book store. Please visit our website at: www.cbhs-sacramento.org.

DRESS

Modesty and good decorum should be the guide for each student's appearance while attending CBHS summer school. CBHS is a private, Catholic college-preparatory school and expects appropriate respect and reverence to its mission. The basic Christian Brothers dress code applies with the following reminders: • Personal grooming should be neat and clean at all times. Hair styles should be modest and non-distracting. • Gentlemen are expected to be clean shaven each day (with the exception of neat mustaches; side burns cannot be below the ears). • Ladies are expected to be modest with their make-up, jewelry, and accessories. • Students must wear official Christian Brothers t-shirts or polo shirts. Students from other campuses must wear appropriately fitting knee- length shorts, long pants or capris. Shoes and socks are required. No sandals or flip-flops. • No bare midriffs or plunging necklines are allowed. • Undergarments should be concealed at all times. • No denim, hats, or sleeveless tops of any kind. • No clothing or accessories with inappropriate symbols or language. • No sagging or baggy pants – pants or shorts should be worn at the natural waistline. • No sweat pants, flannel pants, sweat shorts, beachwear, or sports shorts of any kind. The summer school administration is the final authority regarding appearance, dress code and the consequences regarding students' appearance while attending CBHS Summer Sessions. Please check the website for complete dress code regulations.

IMAGE USE POLICY:

Parents authorize the School to use Student's name, voice, signature, photograph, or likeness, in any manner, including, but not limited to, School materials, publications and promotions, published and distributed in any form, including on the School website.

GENERAL POLICIES

Submitting registration and enrollment materials for a student to attend summer school at Christian Brothers High School is deemed an agreement on his/her part, and on the part of his/her parents/guardians, to comply with all policies, rules, guidelines and regulations of the school as outlined in the Parent/Student Handbook. The Handbook is available on our website. Parents/guardians and students agree that Christian Brothers High School has the right as a private academic institution to make rules that require specific conduct on the part of the parents/guardians and students. Parents/guardians and students agree to comply with required conduct and to support policies and procedures contained herein, and intend to cooperate fully with Christian Brothers High School and its personnel as educational partners. Christian Brothers High School reserves the right to amend or waive provisions of this Handbook when deemed necessary by the President or Principal. No disruptive behavior will be tolerated and will be cause for dismissal with no refund or credit. Christian Brothers is a closed campus. All non-Christian Brothers students enrolling in high school courses must submit a transcript from your current school. No student is permitted to leave the property during school hours. No guests will be allowed during the summer session. Detention will be held for minor infractions of behavior or dress code at 1:00 p.m. for 15 minutes on the day of infraction. Failure to serve detention will result in increased detentions and will be carried over to the fall with additional penalty.

ATTENDANCE

Summer Session is a highly concentrated course of study with each day being equivalent to more than a week of normal school session. Because of this, attendance is crucial: Students are allowed only two absences per three-week session. Family vacations and student holiday plans may not be used as exceptions to these policies. Three tardies are equivalent to one absence. All students must be present for finals.

GENERAL WAIVER

Parents agree and consent to Student participating in all School classes, programs, activities and events, unless Parents provide School written notice to the contrary. Parents acknowledge and understand the risks of accident, serious injury, and even death from participation in all School classes, programs, activities and events. With full understanding of such risks, Parents on behalf of Parents and Student, release the School, its officers, trustees, employees, and agents from any and all liability or any injury incurred by Student while attending the School, and participating in School classes programs, activities and events, from any cause, including but not limited to the ordinary negligence of School, its officers, trustees, employees, and agents.

INDEMNIFICATION

Parents agree to indemnify and hold the School, its officers, trustees, employees, and agents harmless from any and all claims, damages, expenses, and costs of any and all injuries or damages sustained as a result of Student's or Parents' negligent, intentional, or other conduct related to Student attending School and participating in School classes, programs, activities and events.
