GUEST PASS REQUEST FORM

This dance guest pass request is only for students who do not attend Christian Brothers, Jesuit, St. Francis, or Cristo Rey High Schools. The limit is one guest per Christian Brothers High School student. Guests must enter with their host student. Dances at Christian Brothers High School are high-school-age-appropriate events. All students and guests must fulfill the following requirements:

- May not arrive or depart in rented vehicles, limousines, buses, or RV's to any dance
- Be currently enrolled in high school (9th – 12th grade). Freshmen cannot attend dances with seniors.
- Be a student in good standing, verified by the school administration.
- Have a current and valid student identification card from his/her high school.

As a courtesy, Christian Brothers will allow graduates from the four local Catholic high schools (CBHS, Cristo Rey, Jesuit, St. Francis) from the previous year's graduating class only to attend. These graduates must submit a dance contract which includes verification from the school's administration that they were in good standing upon graduation by the stated guest contract deadline. Guests may be no older than 20 years of age. These guests must also provide valid photo identification that includes their date of birth.

No guest may attend who is a former CB student that has been dismissed or been allowed to withdraw under disciplinary circumstances.

GUEST PASS REQUEST FORM IS DUE MONDAY, OCTOBER 8, 2018 BY 4:00PM TO THE LSLO. GUEST PASSES MUST BE 100% COMPLETE OR THEY WILL BE DENIED WITH NO APPEAL.

HOMECOMING DANCE DRESS CODE

Christian Brothers High School has a Homecoming Dance Dress code to encourage students to make appropriate choices and represent themselves well. Any student, including dates from another school, not following the Homecoming Dance Dress Code WILL NOT be allowed to enter the dance.

FOR GIRLS:

Semi-formal dresses are allowed and must meet the following regulations:

- Dresses should be modest and appropriate in style and fit for the CBHS setting
- Strapless and spaghetti strap modestly fitting dresses are allowed
- Dress/skirt length **may not be any shorter than approximately mid-thigh**
- Dress back may not be open lower than the mid-back
- No dresses with a bare midriff or bare lower back allowed
- No dresses allowed revealing excessive cleavage
- Dresses should NOT be excessively tight and short

To ensure approval of dresses, digital photos of girls wearing their dress may be emailed to Mrs. Powers, Dean of Students, well in advance of the dance. Emailed photos should include a front and back picture of the student wearing the dress and the photos should be taken from the same elevation as the student. Girls whose dresses are not pre-approved by Mrs. Powers may be turned away at the door. FOR BOYS:

Semi-formal dress for boys includes

- dress pants or slacks
- dress shirt and tie
- sweaters or jackets, as needed.
- Dress shoes and dark socks are encouraged

FOR ALL:

Students wearing the following items will not be admitted to the dance:

- Clothing that sags, bags, is extremely tight or is low-cut that exposes undergarments or excessive skin
- Glow, strobe, flashing, or light accessories of any kind

ANY student, including guests from another school, not following the Homecoming Dance Dress Code WILL NOT be allowed to enter the dance. CBHS staff makes the final decision regarding appropriateness of student dress.

Once a student is admitted and his/her apparel “regresses” to reveal any of the above, that student will be excused from the dance upon parent notification. Students who fail to comply with the above rules or other school regulations may be subject to:

- Confiscation of student body card and further disciplinary action
- Removal from the dance, notification of parent.

The following BEHAVIOR CODE is expected to be followed for ALL CBHS DANCES:

Students must follow the directives of the adult prefects and security personnel during a dance. The following rules will be in effect at all dances:

1. The school has a right to conduct random breathalyzer tests at dances, upon admittance and at any time during the dance. Detection Canines may be used to survey cars and bags for contraband. Further onsite testing for controlled substances may be called for as well as other forms of tests deemed necessary by the school.
2. Anyone found to be in possession of or under the influence of controlled substances will be turned over to the Deans of Students or the Student Activities Directors. That student will be removed from the dance immediately, required to be tested for controlled substances and/or take a breathalyzer test, and his/her parent will be called. (See RULES OF CONDUCT, #8.) Law enforcement may be notified.
3. Once a student has been admitted to a dance, students will not be allowed to go to their automobiles, lockers, or to the parking lots.
4. Students exhibiting the following may face appropriate consequences:
 - Inappropriate dancing, including straddling another person, lap dancing, grinding, freaking, or any other type of dance considered lewd or potentially dangerous
 - Removal of clothing violating the dance’s dress code.
 - Possession or use of alcohol, drugs, tobacco, electronic cigarettes/vaporizers or other contraband.
5. Appropriate behavior is determined by school staff. First warning may include confiscation of student body card and temporary removal from the dance floor. If unacceptable behavior continues, students will be removed from the dance and their parents may be notified.

6. Any student who is disrespectful or uncooperative and repeatedly fails to comply with the Behavior Code may be subject to immediate removal from the dance, notification of parents, confiscation of student body card, and further disciplinary action (including not being allowed to attend future dances). CBHS staff makes the final decision regarding appropriate behavior.
