Christian Brothers High School Open Dance Information



The four Catholic high schools in the Sacramento area (Christian Brothers, Cristo Rey, Jesuit, and St. Francis) hold age-appropriate dances throughout the school year and may invite students from all four schools to attend. The four schools have a common set of expectations for dress and behavior.

OPEN DANCE DRESS CODE:

Students wearing the following items may not be admitted to the dance or may be asked to adjust their dress:

- Excessively short skirts, dresses, and shorts which are shorter than mid-thigh.
- Tops that expose the stomach, back or chest. No strapless tops or exposed midriffs.
- Clothing with references to alcohol, sex, drugs, racist, sexist, or other derogatory remarks
- Clothing that excessively sags, is low-cut so that it exposes undergarments or excessive skin.

Clothing must not be removed to reveal any of the above items. The final say on appropriate dress is determined by host school staff. If a specific dress code is required for a dance, the host school will announce it in advance.

BEHAVIOR CODE:

Students exhibiting the following may be asked to take a break from dancing or leave the dance entirely:

- Inappropriate physical contact including but not limited to lap dancing, straddling, fighting, unwanted touching, etc.
- “Moshing”, front-to-back dancing, grinding, sandwiching, freaking, break or circle dancing or other types of dancing that are lewd or potentially dangerous.
- Lying or sitting on tables/floors, inappropriate treatment of school property, etc.
- Possession or use of alcohol, drugs, tobacco, electronic cigarettes/vaporizers, or other contraband items.
