

Anonymous Alerts - Communications Tool

We'd like to remind all students and families that CB utilizes a communications tool, <u>Anonymous Alerts</u>, which provides a way for our community to quickly, easily, and anonymously report urgent information to school administrators. The system is designed to allow students, parents, and staff to confidentially report bullying, cyber-bullying, and other sensitive topics through private messages to our administration.

Please be on the lookout for Anonymous Alerts posters on campus, and if you have any questions please contact <u>Joey Elftmann</u> or <u>Matthew Taylor-Viruet</u> in the Deans Office. While this is a wonderful and necessary tool to keeping our campus safe, we also believe the *best* way to address concerns is direct contact with a teacher, school administrator, or counselor. We strongly encourage and fully support that continued practice.

To utilize Anonymous Alerts (app):

- 1. From the App Store, download the free app by searching for "Anonymous Alerts".
- 2. After downloading the app, click on it, enter activation code: christianbhs

All reports remain completely anonymous, although submitters do have the option to reveal their identity if they prefer to have a person-to-person discussion. The program is monitored by multiple school administrators and should only be used for serious and urgent matters. Indeed, if something violent, life threatening or criminal occurs, it is imperative to call 911.
