VISUAL ARTS (Four-year program offered in visual arts)

- Participate in gallery shows, competitions and service projects through the arts
- · Learn the tools and techniques to become a skilled artist

• <u>Classes offered</u>: Introduction to Art I, Introduction to Art II, Art Survey, Advanced Painting, Advanced Painting II, Ceremics Ia, Ceramics Ib, Honors Painting and Drawing, Digital Art (*All classes require the instructor's signature except Introduction to Art I*)

PERFORMING ARTS (Four-year programs offered in choral and instrumental music)

Join choir and you can:

- Enjoy performances, field trips and in-class recordings
- Become a better singer and musician
- Travel past trips include New York City, Belgium, France, Monaco, Switzerland, and Florida
- Ensembles: Men's Choir, Women's Choir, Concert Choir, Chamber Chorus, Honors Chorale I/II, Honors Vocal Jazz,

De La Femme, De La Dudes (All ensembles require audition except Men's Choir and Women's Choir)

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Join instrumental music and you can:

- Enjoy performances, field trips and be a part of pep band
- · Learn to play an instrument and develop musical skills
- Travel past trips include Anaheim, Monterey, Reno, San Francisco, and Santa Cruz
- <u>Ensembles</u>: Beginning Band/Concert Band, Jazz Band, String Ensemble, Honors Band, Drumline, Pep Band (All ensembles require audition except Beginning Band)

- Gain confidence speaking and performing in front of others, and improve your acting skills
- Learn about the world of theatre, including costume and scenic design, musicals, playwriting and stage combat
- · Be part of a dynamic and supportive class environment
- <u>Classes offered</u>: Theatre Arts, Acting Focus (Must complete Theatre Arts first or receive permission from instructor) Don't forget to audition for any of the three school productions or join the tech crew. These activities are available for all students regardless of class schedule.
