VISUAL ARTS (Four-year program offered in visual arts)

- Participate in gallery shows, competitions and service projects through the arts
- Learn the tools and techniques to become a skilled artist
- Classes offered: Introduction to Art, Art Survey I, Art Survey II, Advanced Painting, Advanced Painting II, Ceramics Ia, Ceramics Ib, Honors Painting and Drawing *(All classes require the instructor's signature except Introduction to Art)*

PERFORMING ARTS (Four-year programs offered in choral and instrumental music)

Join choir and you can:

- Enjoy performances, field trips and in-class recordings
- Become a better singer and musician
- Travel – past trips include New York City, Belgium, France, Monaco, Switzerland, and Florida
- Ensembles: Men's Chorus, Women's Chorus, Concert Choir, Chamber Singers, Honors Chorale, Honors Vocal Jazz, De La Femme, De La Dudes *(All ensembles require audition except Men's Chorus and Women's Chorus)*

Join instrumental music and you can:

- Enjoy performances, field trips and be a part of pep band
- Become a better player and musician
- Travel – past trips include Anaheim, Monterey, and Reno
- Ensembles: Beginning Band, Concert Band, Jazz Band, String Ensemble, Honors Band, Drumline, Pep Band *(All ensembles require audition except Beginning Band)*

Join theatre arts and you can:

- Gain confidence speaking and performing in front of others, and improve your acting skills
 - Learn about the world of theatre, including costume and scenic design, musicals, playwriting and stage combat
 - Be part of a dynamic and supportive class environment
 - Classes offered: Theatre Arts, Acting Focus *(Must complete Theatre Arts first or receive permission from instructor)*
- Don't forget to audition for any of the three school productions or join the tech crew. These activities are available for all students regardless of class schedule.*

MEDIA ARTS*

- Join the crew of CB's award-winning, student-run television station, KBFT
- Learn the tools and techniques involved in planning, writing and producing a live-television news broadcast
- Travel – past trips include Anaheim and Orlando for the Student Television Network Convention
- Classes offered (during sophomore, junior and senior year): Introduction to Writing for Publication, Writing for Publication II, Advanced Journalism, Video Production I, Broadcast Journalism, Advanced Media Arts, Sports Broadcasting and Information, Senior Video Yearbook
