Student Expectations thru May 2020

There is a general expectation of participation with authentic effort in Digital Learning Days. A student will not be penalized for circumstances beyond his/her control. However, a student who chooses not to participate with authentic effort in DLDs is subject to consequence. We continue to have teachers, school counselors, and administrators notify parents if it becomes evident that a student is not participating. Each student is responsible for understanding each of their teacher's expectations. What we ask from all students is simply their best effort during this challenging time.

- 1. Letter grades will be assigned for the semester.
- 2. There will be no final exams in the spring 2020 semester. Teachers will have ample student work and prior assessments throughout the semester to assign a grade without a final exam. Therefore, it is imperative to complete all assignments!
- 3. School days start at 9 a.m. each day. Teachers may schedule live (synchronous) participation during their set time.
- 4. Students are expected to complete attendance quizzes by 12 Noon for the classes meeting that day.
- 5. Live sessions with Zoom/Schoology/etc., discussion chats, timed tests or quizzes, etc. will only be held during the allotted class time as noted in the daily calendar.
- 6. No classes can meet during lunch time.
- 7. Teachers will decide how their class time is used. Students should expect teachers hold at least one live Zoom or Schoology conference meeting per week. Every effort to attend is expected. If a student is unable to attend due to personal commitments, lack of technology, etc., the student is expected to communicate and explain the situation to their teacher.
- 8. Teacher will assign work to be submitted and graded. Students have a minimum of 24 hours to complete assignments or to make individual arrangements with teachers.
- 9. Falcon Collaboration Wednesdays are intended to be days when school learning and work continue. On these days, expect teachers to connect with students and their parents who may be struggling or regularly absent, answer questions, provide clarification, and support deeper understanding, rather than to introduce new material. The only assignments due on Wednesday will be for Math and World Languages courses.
- 10. Club meetings may be held during Falcon Flex time on Blue days. Please check in with club moderators for more details.
- 11. Communication during our DLD's is essential. Do not hesitate to message teachers, counselors, or administrators with questions and concerns.
- 12. AP exams are now scheduled exclusively as online exams between May 11 and 22 for most classes (<u>AP exam schedule</u>). Once students complete AP exams, they are no longer expected to attend Digital Learning classes for those courses.
