Job Description

The Falcon Force is a student-led, adult-moderated team of students from Christian Brothers High School with the purpose of fostering school spirit at school events, including (but not limited to) athletic games and rallies.

The expectations of the student members of Falcon Force include:

- Attend weekly planning meetings during a lunch to discuss rallies and upcoming games
- Set-up, run, and clean-up rallies
- Have knowledge of rules of sporting events, including (but not limited to): football, volleyball, water polo, basketball, soccer, baseball, softball, rugby, and lacrosse.
- Actively lead the student cheering section at Holy Bowl, Holy Court and Holy Hoops, regardless of whether the game is at home or away
- Plan to attend senior nights and playoff games.
- Help advertise events and disseminate information about events in which Falcon Force will attend by making or requesting posters from Leadership Class
- Communicate with the adult moderators via Schoology and the school group chat app, GroupMe
- Be in good academic and disciplinary standing at Christian Brothers High School
- Must be at least 30 minutes early to all sporting events Falcon Force is working
- Must wear themed outfits agreed to for games and “uniform” for rallies

In addition to the expectations above, the Falcon Force Rally Chairs must:

- Facilitate the weekly planning meetings
- Communicate directly with the adult moderators on matters of group organization
- Be a senior in good academic and disciplinary standing at Christian Brothers High School
