GUEST PASS REQUEST FORM

The dance guest pass request must be completed by non-CBHS students who do not attend Cristo Rey, Jesuit or St. Francis High Schools. Christian Brothers High School students may only invite **one** guest. **The guests must be in the 10th grade or above and be no older than 19 years old. The guest must be in good standing as verified by their school administration. The guest must have a current school photo ID to enter the dance. No guest may attend who is a former CB student who was dismissed or allowed to withdraw under disciplinary circumstances.**

As a courtesy, Christian Brothers will allow graduates from the four local Catholic high schools (CBHS, Cristo Rey, Jesuit, and St Francis) from the previous year's graduating class ONLY (2021) to attend. These guests must also provide valid photo identification that includes their date of birth.

This *Guest Pass Request Form* is due in the Lasallian Student Life Office no later than **Monday April 25, 2022.**

CBHS Formal Dance Dress Code

CBHS expects students use thoughtful judgment by dressing in formal attire in a respectful and classy manner.

Formal dresses are allowed and must meet the following regulations:

- Dresses should be modest and appropriate in style and fit for the CBHS setting
- Strapless, halter, and spaghetti strap modestly fitting dresses are allowed
- No dresses allowed with a bare midriff or bare lower back
- No dresses allowed revealing excessive cleavage
- No dresses allowed that are excessively tight and/or short

Formal tuxedos or suits are allowed and must meet the following regulations:

- dress pants or slacks
- dress shirt and tie
- jackets and vest optional

Everyone is to wear dress shoes. A second pair of comfortable shoes are allowed for dancing.

ANY student, including guests from another school, not following the Formal Dance Dress Code WILL NOT be allowed to enter the UD Ball. CBHS staff makes the final decision regarding appropriateness of student dress.

CBHS Upper Division Ball Conduct

Students must follow the directives of the adult staff (CB teachers, Sheraton staff, etc.) during the UD Ball. All rules of the *CBHS 21-22 Parent-Student Handbook* are in effect for the UD Ball. Please note the following:

- Students and guests may not arrive or depart in rented vehicles, limousines, buses, recreational vehicles, etc.
- Students and guests should arrive and check-in by 7:00 p.m. when dinner service begins. Once checked into the UD Ball, attendees will not be allowed to leave the venue until 10:30 p.m.
- The school may conduct random breathalyzer tests at dances, upon admittance and at any time during the event; detection canines will be used to survey purses, bags, jackets, and other items brought into the venue.
- Anyone who is in possession of or suspected of being under the influence of alcohol, drugs, tobacco, electronic cigarettes/vaporizers, or other contraband will be remanded to the Dean of Students or other designated CB staff. Such a student will immediately be **removed from the UD Ball**, and parents contacted to pick-up their student. Law enforcement may be notified.
- No unsafe or inappropriate dancing is allowed, this includes, but is not limited to, straddling another person, lap dancing, grinding, freaking and any other type of dance considered lewd or potentially dangerous. Attendees may be warned to adjust their behavior and/or take a break from dancing. If unacceptable dancing continues, the student will be **removed from the dance area** and the parents may be notified.
- Any student who is disrespectful or uncooperative with one of the prefects will be **removed from the event** and parents/guardian may be notified. If a prefect has any difficulty, s/he will seek the help of the Dean of Students.
