## RECRUITMENT PROCESS:

1. Complete the application form and submit a hard copy to the Lasallian Student Life Office (LSLO) Room 106 for review.
  2. You will receive notification that your application has been received. Mr. Jaldon will schedule an interview time with you. **Email is the primary avenue of communication and replies are expected throughout the application process.**
  3. Once your interview is completed, you will be notified by **email** if you have or have not been selected to be a part of the Senior Retreat Leadership Team.
  4. Following your acceptance letter, you will sign an understanding indicating the specific behavior and expectations that are required of leaders (alcohol/drug use, responsible internet use, social behavior). Applicant and parents will sign this contract.
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## QUALIFICATIONS FOR THE SENIOR RETREAT LEADERSHIP TEAM

To be a qualified leader as part of SRLT you need to be able to exemplify the following:

- A belief in God, Jesus, and the Holy Spirit appropriate to your professed religion/faith.
- The ability to be able to discuss matters of faith and God in a respectful manner with your peers.
- Be able to lead prayer.
- Be a responsible Christian leader who demonstrates solid morals, values, attitudes, actions, and behaviors both at CB and off-campus.
- Responsibly share your life experiences with students attending retreats.
- Have leadership skills that exemplify and enable you to facilitate open and honest group discussions through effective communication and listening.
- Leaders must be able to work on a team, and work as a team player with the Lasallian Student Life Office staff and other members of the SRLT.
- A commitment to serving the freshmen, sophomore, **and** junior retreats.
- Have the option to serve in the Summer Kairos from May 30 to June 2.
- **Fully attend and participate in the mandatory SRLT Training Conference from Monday, July 24 to Wednesday, July 26, 2023.**
- All leaders must maintain a **minimum of a 2.5 GPA**
- All leaders must sign this agreement to participate in SRLT.
